

SHORT FINAL AVIATION

2 Year Anniversary Private Pilot Scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP WILL COVER UP TO \$5,000.00 PRIVATE PILOT FLIGHT TRAINING

ENTRY RULES

1. Awarded applicant must be 17 years or older.
2. Awarded applicant will be required to pay a onetime, non-refundable fee of \$5,000.00 prior to initiating training for their private pilot certification.
3. Awarded applicant will purchase the Gold Seal Ground Instruction online program prior to starting flight training.
4. Awarded applicant will possess a 3rd class medical prior to the commencement of flight training.
5. Awarded applicant will have their private pilot knowledge test completed by thirty (30) flight hours or there will be an hourly charge per flight hour after thirty (30) hours, until the knowledge test is completed and passed. Scholarship hours will resume after private pilot knowledge test is completed and passed.
6. Awarded applicant will purchase the Pilots Handbook of Aeronautical Knowledge, Airplane Flying Handbook, E6B, plotter and required navigational charts. (Not required to start flight training)
7. Awarded applicant will be required to pay any third-party expenses such as knowledge test and practical test fees.
8. A runner-up will be selected and notified, contingent upon the awarded applicant not being able to meet the entry rules.

TERMS

1. The date to apply will start January 1, 2020 and will end midnight of April 1, 2020.
2. Applicants may apply from anywhere within the United States, however if awarded, the applicant will be required to fund all travel, lodging and associated expenses to attend training in Twin Falls, Idaho.
2. The review process will be conducted between April 2, 2020 and April 15, 2020.
3. The winner will be notified on April 16, 2020.
4. Flight training will commence May 1, 2020 and must be completed no later than May 1, 2021.
5. Awarded applicant will be required to pay their non-refundable \$5,000.00 prior to May 1, 2020 or the scholarship will be transferred to the runner-up.

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HOW TO ENTER

1. Download and complete the application from the Short Final Aviation website www.shortfinalaviation.net
2. Complete an essay on a separate document and include why Short Final Aviation should award this scholarship to you.
3. Resumes are welcome but not required. Resumes must accompany the application and essay when submitted.
4. Personal reference letters are welcome but not required. Reference letters must accompany the application and essay when submitted. Reference letters should be addressed to "Short Final Aviation Scholarship Program" and must list contact information of the referrer.
